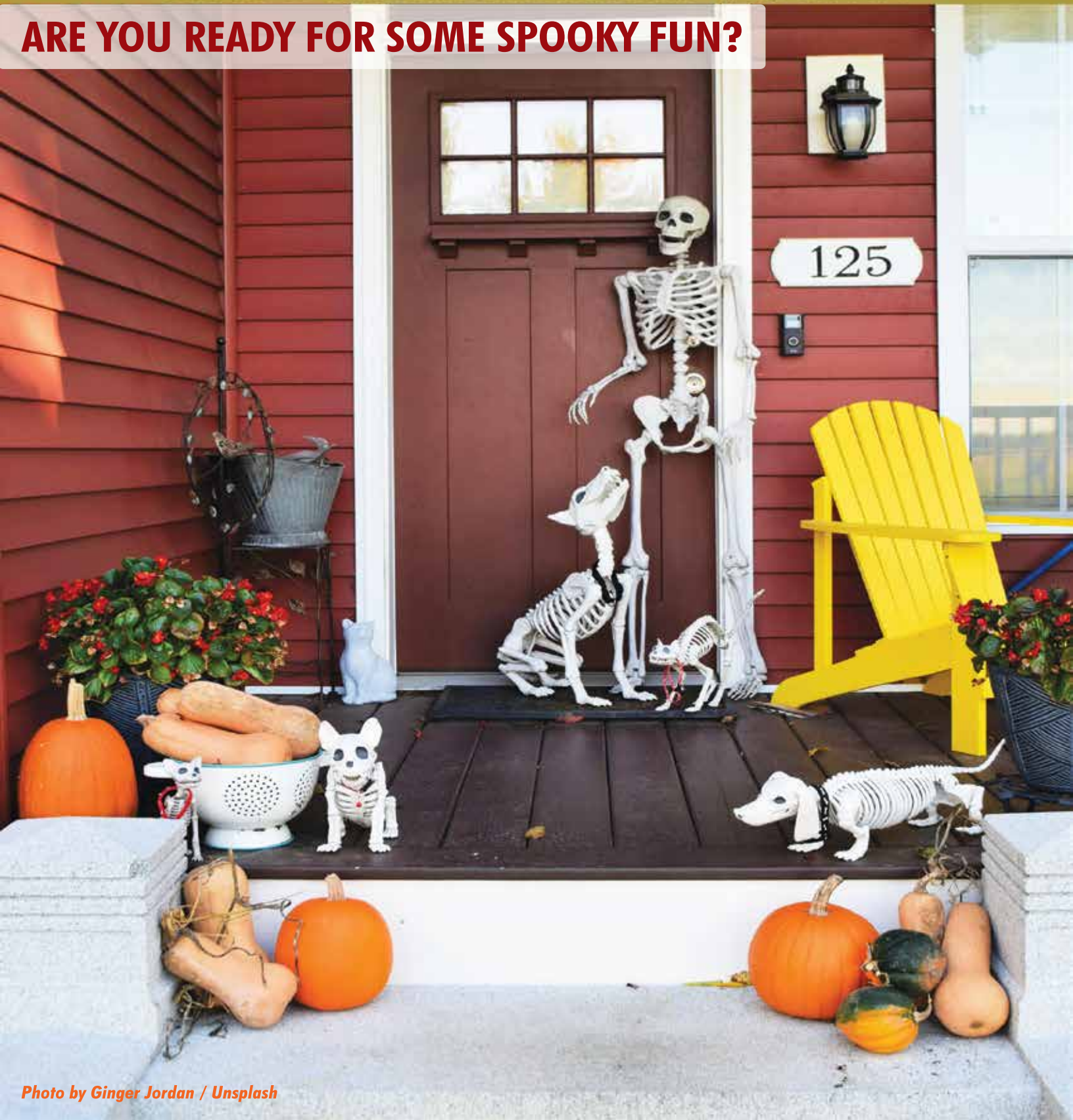

BECOME A HALLOWEEN HERO

If you participated in trick-or-treat adventures as a child, you're part of a long tradition for millions of children. This year, you can teach your own children or grandchildren what it means to become a Halloween hero.

As the longest running youth engagement campaign in the U.S., Trick-or-Treat for UNICEF has taught generations about the power they have to make a difference for the world's children.

The program got its start in 1950 when a handful of kids in Philadelphia collected change in milk cartons (\$17 that first year) to help children in post-World War II Europe. Over the years, the campaign grew into millions of children bringing little orange boxes with them on Halloween night to collect coins while trick-or-treating.

Generations later, kids have raised nearly \$200 million for lifesaving programs for children around the world, providing health care, nutrition, emergency relief and more.

In honor of its 75th year, a month-long initiative is engaging partners and supporters with multiple options for giving.

"For 75 years, the little orange box has inspired generations to turn Halloween into something bigger," said Shelley Diamond, chief marketing officer, UNICEF USA. "Today, whether

through online fundraisers or family friendly activities, we encourage the young – and the young at heart – to put some meaning in their Halloweening all October long."

Donations go to critical, flexible funding that can be used to help children when and where they need it most. The majority of funding goes directly to programs that provide children with essentials like safe water, education and vaccinations against deadly childhood diseases.

Funding makes a meaningful difference in everyday lives. Each \$1 donation could provide a school or community with 30 pencils or two bars of soap. Every \$5 can provide water for a child for a full year or ensure five more children can be vaccinated against measles. An \$8 donation, less than most fast-food meals, could provide a package of 25 diagnostic tests for malaria.

Along with funding critical programs in 157 countries and territories, donations support UNICEF's humanitarian supply network, which rushes essentials like emergency nutrition, blankets or medicine where they're needed, often within 24 hours of a disaster or crisis.

DEADLINE APPROACHING FOR ORANGE COUNTY ARTISTS TO APPLY TO THE 2026 FESTIVAL OF ARTS FINE ART SHOW

The Festival of Arts of Laguna Beach is inviting Orange County artists to apply for the 2026 Fine Art Show before the October 30, 2025, at 4 p.m. deadline. This juried exhibition is one of the most prestigious opportunities for local artists to showcase their work in front of nearly 200,000 visitors at one of the nation's most respected art festivals.

"The Festival of Arts provides artists with an exceptional platform to share their work with thousands of collectors and art enthusiasts," said Christine Georgantas, Exhibits Director. "It's where emerging and established artists alike can connect, inspire, and be celebrated within a vibrant creative community."

Artists interested in participating must submit five digital images per medium and complete the online application at www.foapom.com/ apply by the deadline. Applicants must be 18 years or older and have resided in Orange County for at least one year prior

to October 30, 2025. Proof of residency will be required upon acceptance. Artists wishing to enter multiple mediums must submit a separate application and fee for each.

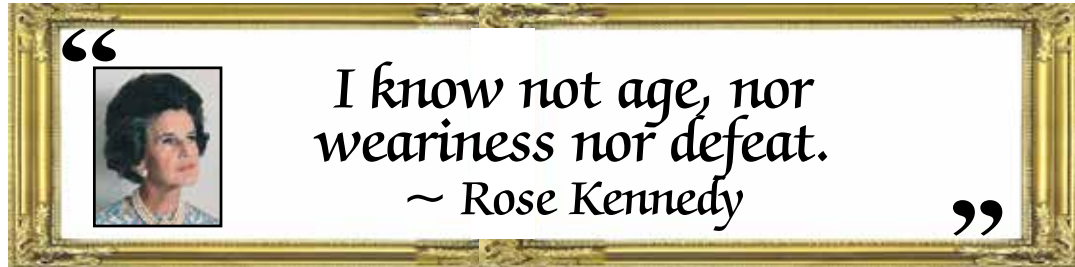
The jurying process is broken into two phases. In the first phase, jurors review and score digital image submissions. Artists whose work advances to the second phase will be invited to present three original pieces for in-person review. Artwork is evaluated based on creativity and originality, craftsmanship, design elements (color, line, shape, form, texture, and space), and professional presentation.

For over 90 years, the Festival of Arts has celebrated the region's rich artistic talent, featuring 120 juried artists each summer across a range of mediums including painting, sculpture, photography, ceramics, jewelry, and more. Selected artists gain invaluable exposure, the opportunity to sell their work, and the prestige of exhibiting at a world-renowned cultural destination.

Chocolate Covered Pumpkin Pretzels

Prep time: 10 minutes

Cook time: 5 minutes

Yield: about 36 pretzels

3/4 cup orange candy melts
1 bag (16 ounces) mini pretzel twists

1/4 cup mini green coated chocolate candies

Line baking sheet with parchment paper and set aside.

In medium microwave-safe bowl, melt candy melts 30 seconds then stir. Working in 15-second intervals, continue microwaving until melted and smooth, stirring between intervals. With fork or dipping utensil, dip 36 mini pretzel twists, one at a time, into melted orange chocolate and gently tap side of bowl to remove excess.

Lay each covered pretzel on parchment paper. Using remaining pretzel twists, break apart enough to equal 1/4 cup.

Place one mini green chocolate candy (to form leaf) and one broken pretzel piece (to form stem) on top of each dipped pretzel. Repeat with remaining pretzels and chocolate candies.

Let set until solid. Pretzels can harden on counter about 30 minutes, or placed in refrigerator or freezer 5-10 minutes. (Culinary.net)

MANSION WITH PRIVATE BEACH & SECRET TUNNEL LISTED FOR \$84.95 MILLION

When you think about celebrity homes, you probably imagine mansions in Hollywood and New York City, but big time stars are increasingly moving to Florida. Escaping California's high taxes and New York's fast pace and frigid winters, some of the country's biggest billionaires and brightest stars have found a haven in Florida's Palm Beach County. North of Miami, the county is known for its sparkling beaches, bucolic countryside, and upscale communities, long a winter colony for New York's old money families. In recent years, they have drawn such luminaries as Bill Gates, Tom Brady, Sylvester Stallone, and Michael Jordan.

The gem of the county is Palm Beach Island itself, a 16-mile-long barrier island that is home to unspoiled beaches and world class country clubs. Billionaire's Row, along Ocean Blvd, is the island's most exclusive address. A new oceanfront estate, listed for \$84.95 million, offers the chance to join this prestigious community in grand style.

The 16,500-square-foot estate features elegant Bermuda-style architecture. Two residences, a five-bedroom main home and a three-bedroom guest house,

surround a resort-style courtyard with a pool, spa, and summer kitchen. A secret tunnel leads under Ocean Blvd to a lovely beach cabana complete with a patio deck and 112 feet of private beach. The nearly one-acre property sits 20 feet above sea level, offering sweeping vistas and added security.

Enter the main residence through the dramatic foyer, featuring an elegant spiral staircase. Inside, sparkling white contrasts with blonde wood, connected by a spacious open floor plan that seamlessly integrates indoor and outdoor spaces. The oceanfront living room is connected to the beautiful formal dining room, while the kitchen offers two islands and top-of-the-line appliances. Downstairs, find a wine cellar, a game room, a great room with fireplace and wet bar, a yoga studio, and one of the best safe rooms in Palm Beach. Custom-engineered with a ballistic door and steel-plated walls, it is built into the reinforced concrete basement for ultimate security. The upper floor contains the bedrooms, highlighted by an expansive primary suite with a private oceanfront balcony connected by French doors, custom built-ins, dual spa-style baths, two walk-in closets, and a morning

mile from Mar-a-Lago and just a few minutes from Palm Beach International Airport, plus world-class shopping and dining of Worth Avenue and vibrant Downtown West Palm Beach.

PREPARING FOR THE FUTURE OF WORK TIPS TO HELP TEENS CHOOSE A CAREER PATH

American teens are preparing for a workforce shaped by AI, new approaches to education and economic uncertainty. While challenges are real, optimism remains high.

In fact, 94% of teens said they are optimistic about their future careers, reflecting a strong sense of hope and ambition, according to research from Junior Achievement and Citizens. The two organizations have partnered for more than 18 years to advance financial empowerment nationwide, with the bank allocating funding and volunteer support, including more than \$630,000 in 2025 to support financial empowerment programs that give people the confidence and tools they need to budget, save, invest and pursue their goals.

However, 57% of teens surveyed believe AI has negatively impacted their career outlook, raising concerns about job replacement and the need for new skills.

“Today’s teens face a rapidly changing world, from the rise of AI to shifts in education and careers,” said Susan LaMonica, chief human resources officer at Citizens. “The survey shows they know the importance of adaptability and continuous learning.”

To help teens build skills for emerging roles and navigate their futures, consider these tips from the experts at Junior Achievement, the world’s largest

organization dedicated to giving young people the knowledge and skills they need to own their economic success, plan for their futures and make smart academic and economic choices.

Explore Internships

Success depends on more than credentials alone. Survey respondents believe networking (50%) and internships (41%) are keys to future success. What’s more, 56% believe real-world experience is more valuable than a four-year degree. Internships can provide that experience and allow students to test their interest in a field while building their professional networks, developing skills that can be applied to a range of career paths, identifying strengths and weaknesses and clarifying future goals.

Consider Post-High School Education

Teens’ perspectives on education reflect their uneasiness. Only 40% of teens surveyed believe a four-year degree is always a good investment. At the same time, about 6 in 10 believe a bachelor’s or graduate degree is still necessary for their chosen profession, which shows how complicated these decisions can be. While many careers require a college diploma, that isn’t the only path to career success. In addition to traditional four-year universities, consider alternate education paths such as trade schools or technical programs, apprenticeships, two-year degree programs or professional certifications



if applicable to your career path.

Weigh Passion Against Pay

While most teens surveyed (63%) said they would prefer a good-paying job even if it comes with stress, many are weighing passion against pay as they explore career opportunities. In fact, some top industries in which teens plan to pursue a job include health care and life sciences (30%), arts and music (27%) and content creation and digital media (25%), further showcasing that willingness. Many students are also exploring less traditional routes to build security and opportunity, with 87% expecting to earn extra income through

side hustles, gig work or social media content creation.

“The data illustrates how the stressors on young people are compounding year after year,” said Tim Greinert, president of Junior Achievement USA. “It also shows how resilient and savvy students are these days in terms of understanding the world around them and deciphering the best path to the future that’s best for them.”
